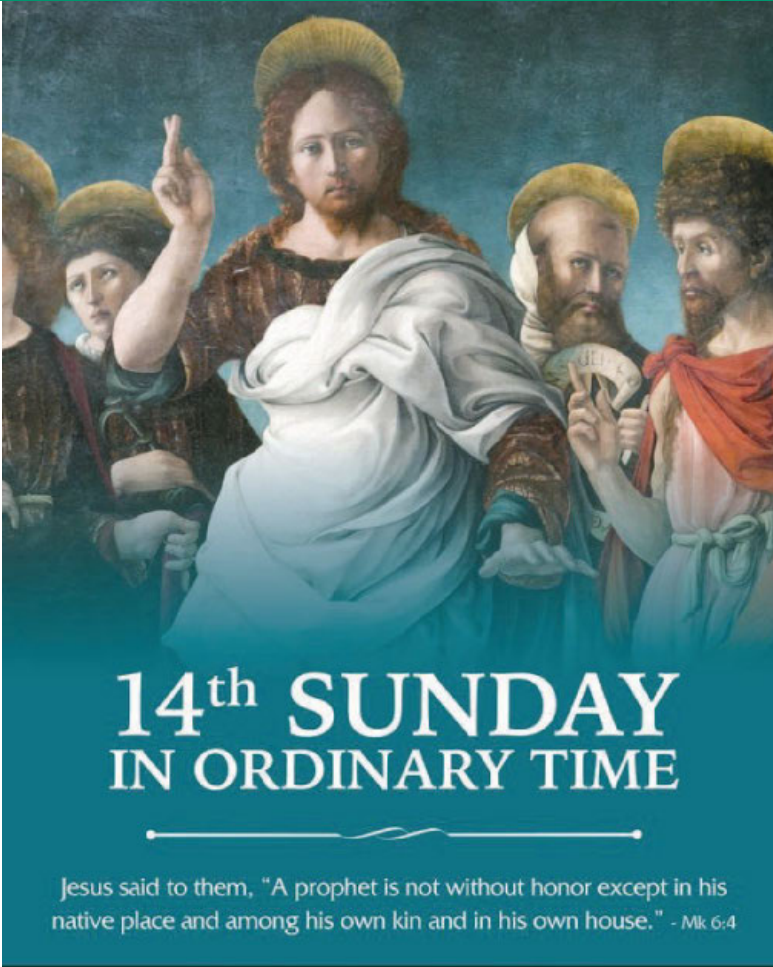

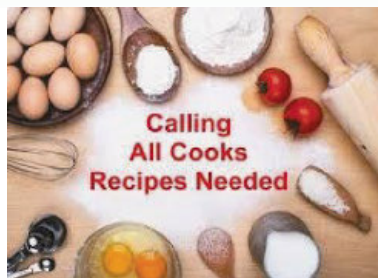

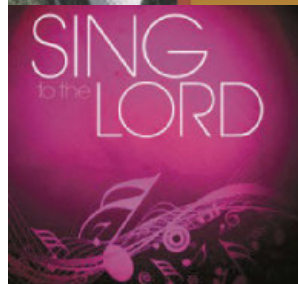

SAFE ENVIRONMENT INFORMATION
